The purpose of the survey is to study the level of satisfaction of applicants with the quality of teaching disciplines.


The survey was conducted using the information resource GOOGLE FORMS anonymously and on a voluntary basis.

The questionnaire offered to students presents 15 questions. The form of the questionnaire is attached (Appendix 1).


The generalized results of the survey are shown in the diagrams below. The results of the survey show that applicants for higher education are interested in improving the quality of the educational process at the University.

1. What proportion of classroom activities under this course have you attended?




2. At the very beginning the teacher carefully and clearly explained


3. Is there enough (time) hours allocated for finishing this course (achieving learning outcomes)?
















10. Did the teacher clearly, easily and carefully provided the material, and was able to interest you with this material?






12. What distance learning tools did the teacher use during the quarantine?






